At Flagstone State Community College our Academic Excellence classes are designed to support and foster the development of high achieving students.

The program provides students with a differentiated pedagogy to extend, develop and maximise their capabilities as learners. The program is driven by four key values; collaboration, critical and creative thinking, communication and resilience. To inspire success every day, these values are taught to encourage students to strive for academic excellence in an innovative and supportive learning environment to meet their full potential as lifelong learners.

Academic excellence classes run across core subjects. In Years 7, 8 and 9 students can apply to enter or maintain their position. These core subjects are English, Humanities, Maths and Science. Students in the program will be provided with opportunities to extend themselves academically by participating in challenges and State and/or National competitions and programs in partnership with organisations such as Griffith University and ABCN.

PROGRAM STANDARDS AND EXPECTATIONS

Program students are expected to actively and positively engage in all aspects of school life, both in and outside of the classroom. Very high standards of effort are expected at all times, in all learning areas and through enrichment opportunities. PROGRAM REVIEW PROCESS

Academic excellence students are reviewed in a cyclic manner throughout the year. If student's results do not maintain the above criteria, they are at risk of being removed from the program. This will be based on individual circumstances. Parents/carers will be contacted to discuss relevant concerns. A probationary period may be granted in which a student will set goals / strategies that will allow students to continue to extend their learning and maintain their place within the excellence program by the end of the review timeline. If by the end of the review timeline the results have not improved, the student will be withdrawn from the program.

STUDENT SUPPORT

Support staff are available to help any student feeling anxious, overwhelmed or stressed. These staff include their Year Coordinator, Subject Teachers, Curriculum Head of Department, Guidance Officer, and the Teaching and Learning Head of Department.
