Under this agreement for 2017

Flagstone State Community College will receive

\$264,020*

This funding will be used to

- improve the percentage of Year 7 students meeting National Minimum Standards in Reading from 89.1% to 92%, in Writing from 86% to 88% and in Numeracy from 94.1% to 96%, by 2018
- improve the percentage of Year 9 students meeting National Minimum Standards in Reading from 88.6% to 91%, Writing from 67.8% to 70% and Numeracy from 88.6% to 90%, by 2018
- ensure 100% of Year 12 students exit with a Queensland Certificate of Education
- continue to improve teacher capacity through professional development, coaching and engagement in collaborative planning teams

Our initiatives include


- implementing the Reading to Learn strategy
- continuing to engage teachers in Collaborative Planning Teams tasked with developing strategies to improve student learning outcomes
- engaging teachers in coaching to improve classroom instruction of reading and numeracy
- continuing to improve strategies for monitoring and tracking Year 11 and 12 performance and early intervention
- employing a .5FTE Success coach to enhance the .5FTE Success Coach position supplied by Central Office

Our school will improve student outcomes by

1.employing an additional .6 FTE teacher permitting the release of a trained teacher to act as Reading to Learn Coach who is tasked with ➤ professional development of teachers in the Reading to Learn strategy ➤ coaching of teachers in Reading to Learn strategies and lesson / unit planning	\$40,367
2.professional development for teachers in Reading to Learn strategy	\$ 4,742
3.employing an additional .5FTE teacher permitting the release of a trained teacher to act as Numeracy Coach who is tasked to: ➤ develop intervention plans for each student identified as potentially below NMS and assist teachers in delivery of these plans ➤ provide training for teachers in delivering numeracy intervention strategies ➤ coach teachers in developing and delivering strategies to improve students' numeracy skills	\$33,639
4.appointing a HOD – Senior Schooling to develop and implement a process for monitoring and tracking Year 11 and 12 performance and early intervention	\$124,563
5.appointing a .5FTE Success Coach to engage at risk students	\$60,709
